- I. The Source of Spiritual Renewal: God's Glorious Riches (16)
 - It's not something you can do!
 - It's God-given
 - The supply is limitless

Immeasurably More Ephesians 3:14-21

- II. The Place of Spiritual Renewal: Your Inner Being (16)
 - The inner springs of the heart are more important than the greatest accomplishments of our actions, our words, or our reputations
 - When our souls are empty, the vitality of our lives will be weak & anemic

- III. The Central Reality of Spiritual Renewal: The Indwelling of Christ (17)
 - "with power through his Spirit"
 - "that Christ may dwell in your hearts"

- I. The Biblical Vision of Human Existence: A Life Worthy of our Calling (4:1-6)
 - Characterized by godly virtues (2-3)
 - "humility" (2a)
 - "gentleness" (2b)
 - "patience" (2c)
 - forbearance in love (2d)
 - ■relentless pursuit of spiritual unity (3)



The Gift and Goal of Growing Up Ephesians 4:1-16

- I. The Biblical Vision of Human Existence: A Life Worthy of our Calling (4:1-6)
 - Characterized by godly virtues (2-3)
 - Radiant of the Unity of the Holy Trinity (4-6)
 - "one body"; "one Spirit"; "one hope" (4a; cf. also 3)
 - "one Lord, one faith, one baptism" (5)
 - "one God and Father of all" (6)



The Gift and Goal of Growing Up Ephesians 4:1-16

- II. The Singular Purpose of Christian Ministry (4:7-13)
 - Grounded in the Gifts of God's Grace (7, 11)
 - Gifts given to all (7)
 - "to each of us"
 - Gifts given to some (11)
- "some"; "some"; "some" [$\mu \varepsilon \nu ... \delta \varepsilon$] [NB: Paul's fuller teaching on spiritual gifts in Ro. 12 and 1 Cor. 12-14]



The Gift and Goal of Growing Up Ephesians 4:1-16

- II. The Singular Purpose of Christian Ministry (4:7-13)
 - Grounded in the Gifts of God's Grace (7, 11)
 - Experienced in the Spiritual Health of the Body Note key terms:
 - "Until all come" (13):
 - "To equip" (12) (see Mk. 1:19; Gal. 6:1; 1 Cor. 1:10) "to unity of the faith"
 - "For building up"
- "and knowledge of the Son"
- "to maturity . . . the full stature of Christ"

 - But this! (4:20-5:17)
 - Renewed minds (23)
 - A new self according to the likeness of God (24)
 - "In true righteousness and holiness" (24)
 - Godly speech (25, 29, 5:4)
 - Godly attitudes (26, 31-32, 5:1)
 - Godly desires (5:3, 5)
